

Section H: Comprehension (Selected Response) (5 marks)

Princess Vela of France was born deaf in 1865. She learned to lip-read at a young age and could speak several languages. She later married Prince Carlos and moved to Hungary. They had three children and she communicated with them in sign language. Despite being disabled, Princess Vela was not discouraged. Instead, she served God by helping people because she 5 believed that it was God's purpose for her to do good works.

Over the years, Hungary had suffered much through several wars which brought hardship to her people and to the royal family. Still, Princess Vela did many charitable works and helped the poor. Unfortunately, her husband left her and she had a nervous breakdown. Immediately, she was sent to a mental 10 hospital against her will. She did not even get a chance to say goodbye to her children. Her youngest son, six-year-old Raymond, was devastated when he returned from a carnival and found his mother gone.

After she was discharged from the mental hospital, she worked with the Treta which was an organisation that provided food and shelter for orphaned 15 children.

Princess Vela died in 1969 with no possessions as she had so generously given everything she had to the poor. To this day, she is remembered as a kind woman who lived out her faith through her good works. 19


