Louise Braille was one of the few people who have changed the world 5 in major ways. Born in 1809 in France, Louise was an only child with perfect eyesight. His father was a leathersmith and Louise enjoyed exploring in his workshop, imitating his dad. When he was three, Louise injured his eye when playing with a tool. Infection eventually blinded him in both eyes.

Although Louise's parents were not rich they were determined to 10 provide their son with the same opportunities as other children. So, they sent him to school to learn. After two years of hard work, he came up with a new system which required just a fingertip to 15 read.
