Section I: Comprehension open-ended (20 marks)

I was in Philadelphia for a work conference when I saw an advertisement in the hotel lobby. A nearby theatre was screening a documentary about several local animal shelters that were helping to save dogs from high-kill shelters in the South. I love animals and this fundraising event sounded right up my alley. However, none of my co-workers would go with me. I was worried about navigating the streets by myself at night alone.

I resigned myself to spending the evening in my hotel room but as soon as I got back to my room, I felt restless and bored. The theatre where the event was taking place was only about five blocks away from the hotel. How lost could I get? The area around the hotel did not seem particularly dangerous. Hence, I decided to brave it. I gathered up my wallet and room key and set off.

It was already getting dark as I made my way down the street. The hotel was located in the business district and the streets were nearly deserted. I managed to find the street the theatre was on but when I turned the corner, I stopped in shock. The street in front of the theatre was chock full of bikers — lots and lots of very big, tough-looking bikers.

Now, I was a woman all alone in a strange neighbourhood at night. There in front of me were twenty or so very large men, all wearing insignia that denoted they were in some sort of club or gang. Like most women in that situation, warning bells began to sound and my heart jumped in my throat. Then, horrified thoughts invaded my mind. Was I at the right theatre? I sourced into the theatre, which turned out to contain even more bikers than the street outside. What was going on? I paid for a ticket and moved inside where I anxiously took a seat, chiding myself over and over again for going on this little adventure in the first place.

As I sat there, heart racing, waiting for the film to start, I muttered a prayer to put my anxieties out of my mind. A local blues-rock band was the opening act and within a few minutes, their performance drew my attention. They were really good. In fact, I later went online and bought all of their albums. Enthusiasm for the band's performance soon took away all of the worries from my mind and I began to relax and have a good time.

After the band was done, the emcee took the stage and introduced us to the try Chihushus that he had adopted through the effort detailed in the documentary. Then the film began to play and I understood the presence of the bixers after a conversation with the emcee. They had been part of the caravan that escorted the animals from New Jersey to Philadelphia two days ago. They were all part of an animal rescue group. At that moment, I was struck by the bonds that had drawn so many disparate tolks to the theatre that night. We had been brought together by our shared love of animals. I made new friends, discovered a new band I love, and supported an important cause. I stayed till the very end and made it to my hotel without any incident. Something gave me courage to venture into the unknown and the result was one of the best nights of my life.




