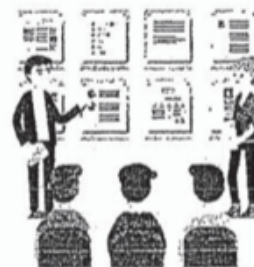




**OVERSEAS PROJECTS**
